2,426 families experienced relief because of the Pinky Swear community.

You provided critical financial support to families facing childhood cancer – like Aamir and his family.

Immediately after Aamir’s leukemia diagnosis, he was flown by helicopter to a different hospital that had a pediatric intensive care unit for a week-and-a-half-long stay. Extra passengers weren’t allowed. His single mom, Lethecia, made the hour-long drive alone, racing to meet her son. Their life had changed immediately – there wasn’t even time to pack a bag.

After seeing his treatment roadmap, Lethecia knew right away that working would be impossible. She needed to be with her son. But bills were piling up. She remembers feeling alone.

Support from Pinky Swear came at just the right time – because of your compassion and generosity. Together, we paid Lethecia and Aamir’s mortgage and helped with gas and grocery expenses.
