



STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Pinky Swear Foundation has a mission to help kids with cancer and their families with financial and emotional support. The foundation has always been centered around “kids helping kids” and honoring students who support the original pinky swear promise. Pinky Swear will be awarding individuals scholarships, up to \$1,500, to recognize their efforts. The goal of the scholarship is to celebrate talented student leaders who have strived to support children battling cancer.

Eligibility:

Ages eight to 21 and must be active in the Pinky Swear PAKK, Youth Leadership Council (YLC) or have been an active Pinky Swear Foundation Youth Volunteer for the past six months.

Criteria for award determination:

- **Leadership:** Attending PAKK or YLC Meetings and being an active member while in attendance. Also supporting kids battling cancer by attending Pinky Swear events and being an advocate for the organization.
- **Dollars fundraised:** Personal fundraising campaigns.
- **Connection to childhood cancer:** An understanding of how cancer affects a child and family.

How to Apply

Visit pinkyswear.org/scholarship or request an application from Frankie Behr, Student Leadership Manager at frankie.behr@pinkyswear.org. Completed applications are due May 7th, 2021 and will be reviewed by the Pinky Swear Scholarship Committee. All applicants will be notified of the committee’s decision by end of May 2021. All eligible applicants are encouraged to apply again in the future. Scholarship recipients will be asked to attend a recognition ceremony – date yet to be determined.

*Pinky Swear Foundation will award the Student Scholarship up to four times. All funds will be deposited into a 529 college savings fund or paid to the college, university or vocational program where the student is enrolled.
